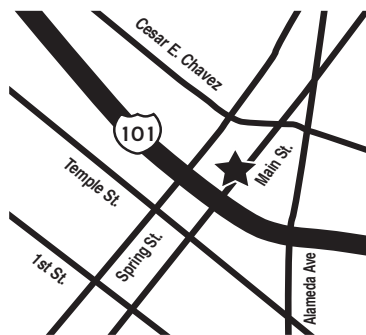

Schafik Jorge Handal, son of Palestinian immigrants, was born in Usulután, El Salvador on October 14, 1930. His participation in the politics of El Salvador goes back to 1944 when he was a part of the movement that ousted the dictator Maximiliano Hernández Martínez.

In 1979 he participated in the unification of opposition parties into the national alliance known as the Frente Farabundo Martí para la Liberación Nacional (FMLN). From 1990 to 1991 he headed the FMLN's commission that negotiated and signed the Peace accords that ended the long civil war in El Salvador.

In 1997, Schafik Handal was elected to the Legislative Assembly as Congressman. He was re-elected to another congressional term in 2000. He is currently President of the Commission of the Electoral and Constitutional Reforms.
